



Washburn Amateur Hockey Association Volunteer Agreement 2009-2010 Season

Note- This agreement does not apply to Mini-Mite families.

Volunteering is the life-blood to running a successful hockey program. With the exception of a few paid coaching & staff positions, everyone who participates in operating WAHA is a volunteer.

I understand that in order to complete Registration and before my player(s) will be allowed to play, each family is required to:

Provide a personal check may payable to "Washburn Hockey" or "WAHA" in the amount of \$200.00. This check will be held as a deposit and WILL NOT BE CASHED unless the family does not satisfy it's volunteer requirement of 20 hours of service to WAHA for the 2009-2010 hockey season. Upon completion of the volunteer requirement, the deposit check will be voided and destroyed.

The following positions automatically qualify for completion of volunteer service to WAHA:

- Coach (Head or Assistant)
- Team Manager
- Level Coordinator
- Board Member

The following opportunities have positions that qualify for volunteer service based on the number of hours worked. You can contact the leaders of these opportunities (once posted on the WAHA web site) to learn what positions are available at these functions. It is the responsibility of the parents to keep track of the hours worked by each family:

- Registration
- WAHA Day
- Picture Day
- Washburn Wings of Spring Tournament
- District Tournaments

I understand that volunteering for opportunities that are not sponsored by Washburn does not apply toward your Washburn volunteering service.
